The Beginning of project

In 2006, the HEDSPI project was started by the Hanoi University of Technology under the ODA of Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs to train high-level IT engineers who can speak Japanese, and Sun* took over the project in 2014. Now expanded to include six universities in three countries.

I want to really touch my favorite Japanese culture.

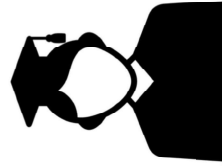


* Why you started to learn Japanese ?
